

PARTY Piece by Richard Harris is a fast paced comedy set in the neighbouring back gardens of two Victorian terraced houses.

Michael and Roma throw a fancy dress house warming party that soon turns out to be a disaster. Most of the guests they invited do not turn up and they eventually end up inviting their nosey next-door neighbour, her son and his difficult new wife.

A lot of work had obviously gone into the impressive set designed by Cyril Mighall complete with sheds and garden furniture. The smoke effects of the barbecue were excellent and used to good effect. I did feel however that the lighting was a little harsh for the set.

Guy Hudson as Dr Michael Smethurst and Jackie Lucas as his wife Roma gave strong performances. The great height difference between the two gave their paring an extra comic dimension and their interaction reminded me of Basil and Sybil Fawlty. The very tall Hudson was good at physical comedy to which the audience responded to favourably. Lucas had good facial expression conveying the absurdity of various situations and played her character well - they were good together.

Di Brooke as the interfering next-door neighbour Mrs. Hinson portrayed her character as the mother-in-law from hell well. She has a good sense of comic timing and for me was the star of the night. Her son David played by Craig Phelan also gave a good performance although at times looked slightly awkward on stage.

Emma Davey as David's wife Jennifer gave a strong, believable and polished performance and had real stage presence. Although Matt Horan who played Toby Hancock had few lines, he played the comedy of his role well. Sally Harling as the man-eating Sandy was breath of fresh air on stage and very funny.

Director Barbara Saunders delivered a good performance from her cast. The village hall was packed out and the audience appreciative of the evening's entertainment.
